Keep Our Children Safe

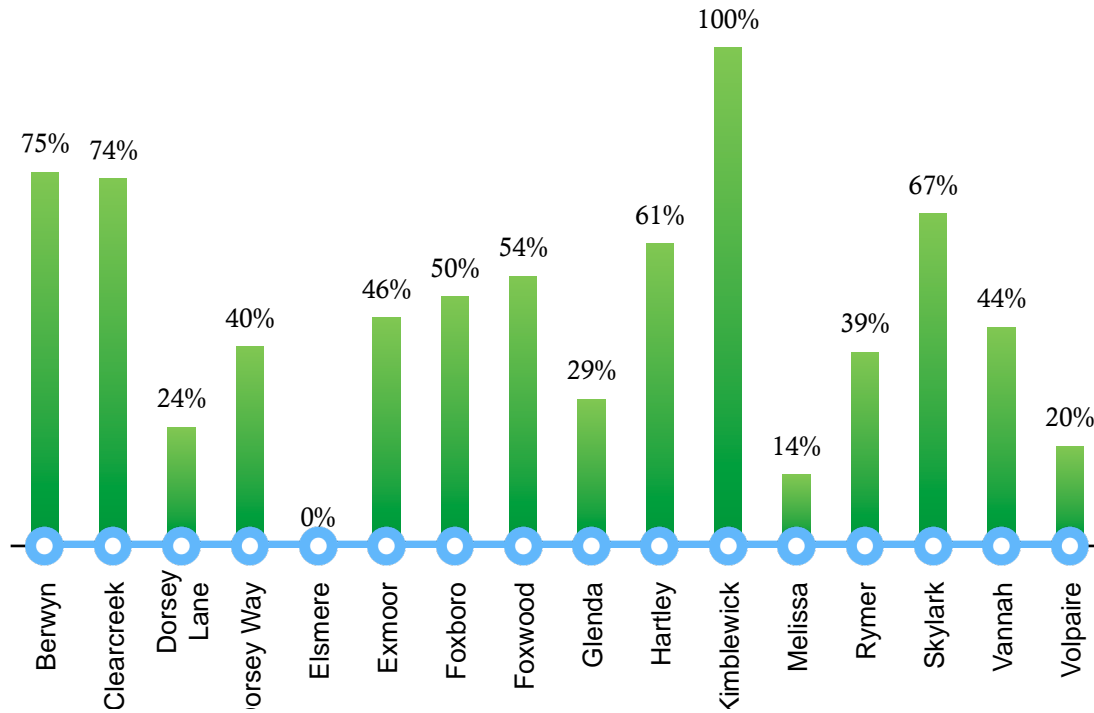
Remember – school is back in session and the mornings are dark. Please **slow down** through the neighborhood – particularly where children are walking to and from or waiting for a school bus.
