

NOTES FROM FOXBORO NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION MEETING
SEPTEMBER 11, 2012

The meeting began at 7:06 p.m. There were five households represented at the meeting. In accordance with the organizations by-laws no business could be conducted since there was not a quorum (10).

President Jon-Paul Moody conducted an information only meeting. The following information was shared:

- Treasurer Pam Thorpe reported on the status of dues collections for the year. We are \$225 short of our budgeted goal of \$8000. Most contributions have been \$50 each. More are expected.
- Pam reported that the current bank account balance is \$9995.04. We expect to come under budget for the year. The anticipated increase in our LGE expenses did not materialize.
- Jon-Paul announced that he has turned in the signed contract to redo the neighborhood entrance ways, to add new plants and shrubs, and to update the irrigation systems. Funding in the amount of \$2808 is being provided by Metro Councilman Ackerson's office. We appreciate all the support Councilman Ackerson has given the association.
- Jon-Paul announced that two neighborhood streets, Foxwood and Skylark were recently re-paved. The project was supported by Louisville Metro, and Mr. Ackerson.
- Helen Haury of the welcoming Committee announced that 5 new families have moved into Foxboro: Todd, 10015 Foxboro; Bayus, 618 Rymer; Garner, 620 Rymer; Dyer, 814 Foxwood; and Shephard, 822 Skylark. If anyone knows of other new neighbors please advise Helen Haury.
- Jon-Paul stated that we will need candidates for the board election to be held in November. Anyone interested in running for any of the board positions should contact any current board member.
- VP Jerry Clark gave a special note of thanks to Pam & Norb Thorpe for all of the work they did this year in support of the association; setting up for meetings, working on the entrance ways, etc.

The next meeting is scheduled for 7 p.m. on November 13, at the Firehouse. Elections for next years board members will be conducted.
