FOXBORO FACTS

Did you know that:

- Foxboro is a community made up of 370 houses. It takes everyone's help to maintain this community. The % of residents who paid their association dues for the past 3 years has been a dismal 39, 43, and 37%. Several residents pay extra to make up the deficit but that is an unfair situation as *all residents* benefit from having the streetlights.
- The Foxboro community is responsible for paying for 100% of the electricity used by the street lights in the neighborhood. *No metro government funds are used to pay these bills.*
- The electricity expense alone represented 73% of the dues collected last year. And there are other expenses in the neighborhood as well.
- The elected board communicates neighborhood information via email. The email addresses on the neighborhood list are NEVER sold or shared. Please provide an email address—if you haven't already—to be used for these communications.
