

MINUTES FROM FOXBORO NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION MEETING

NOVEMBER 11, 2014

The meeting was called to order by President Jerry Clark at 7:00 P.M.

The minutes from the January 24, 2014 meeting (which were posted on the Association website since March) were approved. Judy Wood made the motion to approve; Carol Cull seconded the motion.

This being Veterans Day, President Clark thanked all veterans for their service to our country.

President Clark then announced that two officers from the current year agreed to stay on for another term: Adam Hoette and Janet Lynsavage. Adam Hoette agreed to serve as President; Janet Lynsavage agreed to stay on as treasurer. Elaine Terry volunteered to be secretary; Stan Domzalski volunteered to serve as vice-president.

The following were unanimously approved by voice vote to be officers for 2015:

Vice-President: Stan Domzalski

Secretary: Elaine Terry

Treasurer: Janet Lynsavage

The budget for 2015 was presented by Treasurer Janet Lynsavage. The budget was previously distributed via email and is essentially the same as last year's with expenses projected at \$8500. To date for 2014 one hundred and sixty-seven (167) households contributed about \$9700. One member asked if we had budgeted for a projected increase in rates by LGE. We are planning for that increase. Ron Varda made a motion to approve the budget; Judy Wood seconded the motion. The budget was approved unanimously.

There was some discussion about getting more lights on Dorsey Way. The cost of additional lighting was discussed. Kimblewick Drive added 2 additional lights last year. They cost about \$20 per month and the residents on that street are paying for them.

One resident suggested that we put more mulch on the entrances to Foxboro. We may have sufficient funds to do that in spring, 2015.

Helen Haury announced that she welcomed 8 new families who have moved in recently. She said that local merchants Fresh Market, Cookies By Design, and Heintzman's Bakery make donations for her welcoming packets. She asked that we patronize these merchants. She also said that any business that anyone in Foxboro knows of or is associated with is welcome to contribute to the welcoming packages.

The decorating of the entrance ways for Christmas will take place on Saturday, November 29, at 10:00 A.M. Volunteers are welcome and we are to meet at the Foxboro - Dorsey Lane entrance. A suggestions

was made to see if we could step up the quality of the island decorations. The cost for doing something more will be investigated but in the meantime, anyone who has extra decorations is welcome to donate them to the Association.

Lindy Meadows commented that the Halloween outing for the children was a success despite the weather. She suggested that the association should consider having more such social events. She volunteered, and was approved unanimously, to be social director for the Association. In that role she can coordinate social events for the Association.

The next Association meeting will be scheduled for March, 2015. That will enable us to better plan for the spring and summer months, and for the remainder of the year.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:26 PM.
