The crews from Wright Tree Service did a tremendous job in their cutting, their consideration of the homeowner's property, and in leaving the wood as neat as possible.

The bad news - besides the loss of these mature trees - is that there is a lot of wood left on Foxboro properties. The good news - if you have a wood-burning fireplace - is that there is a lot of firewood available.

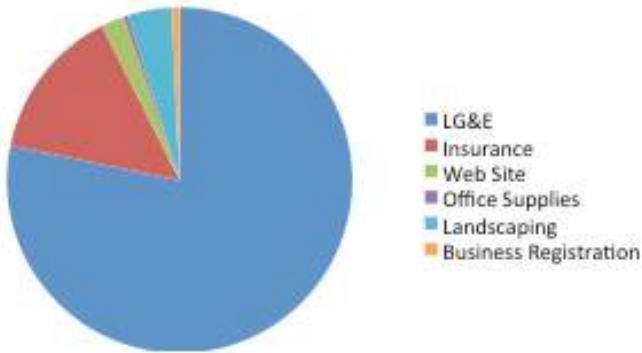

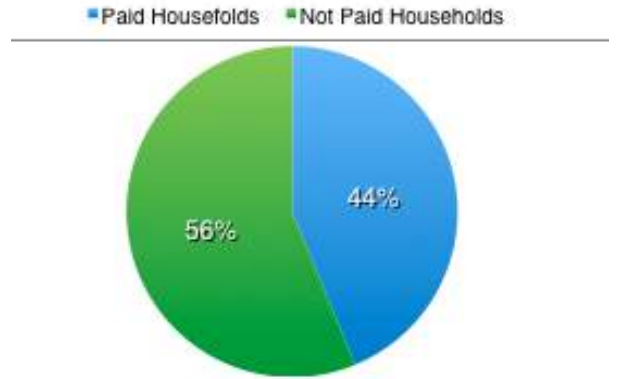

Foxboro Expenses Pie Chart

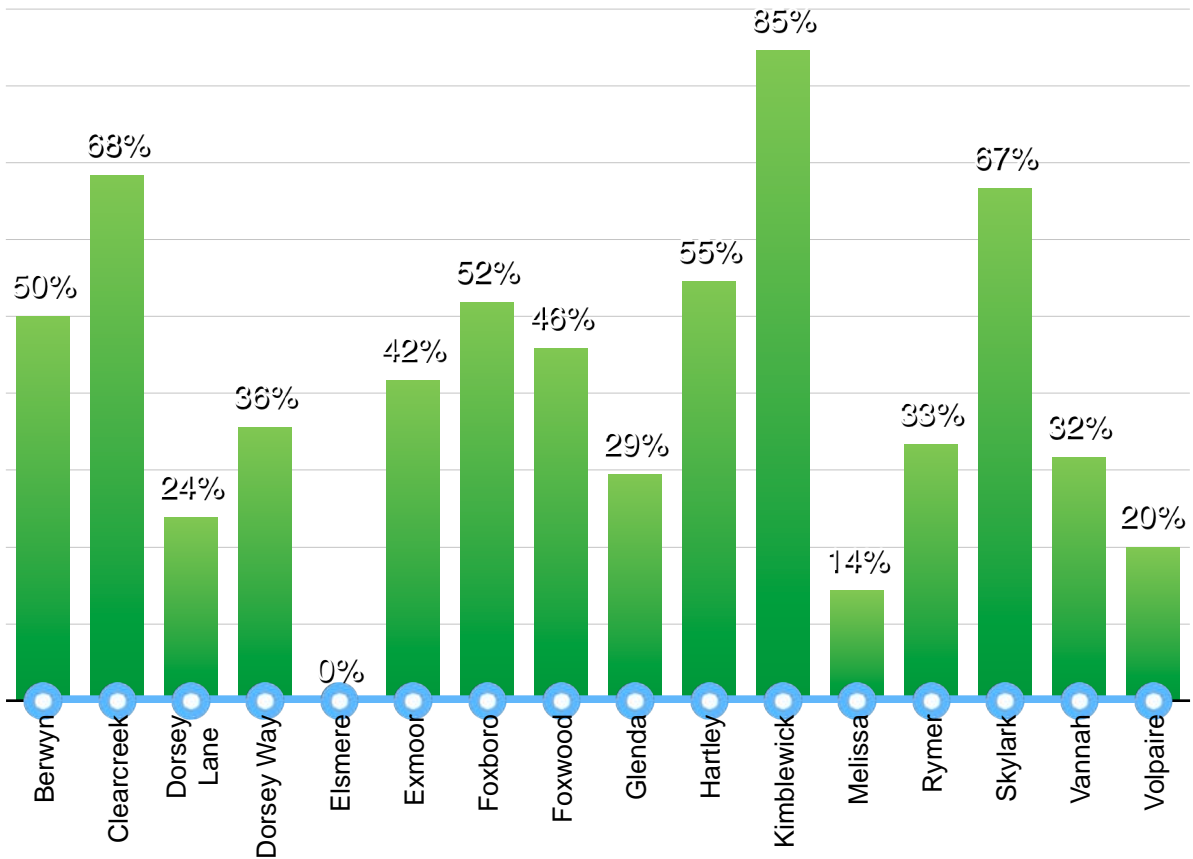


Contribution Rate Pie Chart
