The Foxboro Neighborhood

Foxboro consists of 370 homes, 2 entrance islands, one open space where a pool used to be – now referred to as Foxboro Common, and 29 street lights. We – and that means ALL of the Foxboro residents – are responsible for paying for and maintaining those common areas. There are no other sources of funds to pay for these expenses beyond the \$50/year annual contribution to the neighborhood operating fund. Due to our contribution rate of less than 50%, Foxboro dues are used for nothing but essentials, there is no room for any real projects. The money goes to LG&E (83%), insurance (9.5%), islands and green space (4%), and supplies/business expenses (3%).

If you are a resident who chooses not to contribute your share, then please do not expect those of us volunteering our time and energy to make this neighborhood a nice place to live, to provide neighborhood services – emails, etc. The tag line on the Foxboro neighborhood emails has a real meaning. If you want your neighborhood to be there for you, then be there for your neighborhood.

Thank You (but more help is needed)

Thank you to all the volunteers who keep our entrance islands and common spaces looking nice by cutting the grass. We still *need more volunteers* to chip in with weeding, litter pickup, and watering the flowers in the planter boxes now that the hot and dry weather is here. Please help maintain the quality of this neighborhood by keep up the common areas as well as your property.



Summer Event – call for Volunteers

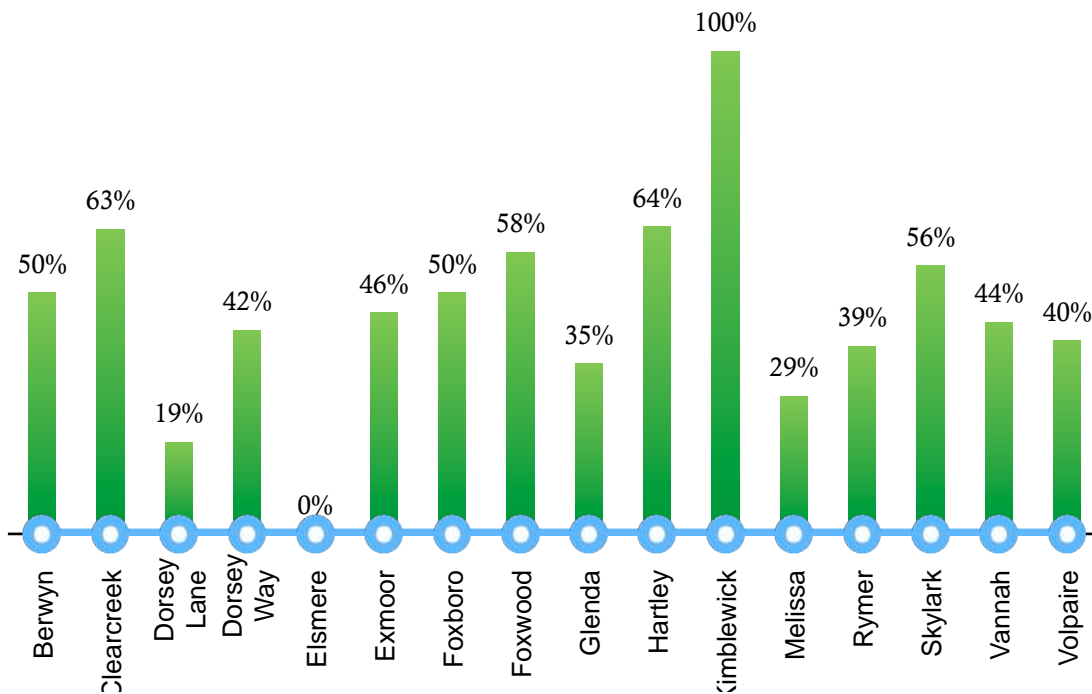
