

Foxboro Neighborhood meeting Sunday, May 7, 2017 at the Shelbyville Road Firehouse

Meeting called to order by Adam Hoette, President. He welcomed neighbors to the meeting, fourteen signed in. The attendance sheet is attached.

Adam announced that there are about one fourth of the neighbors that have paid their 2017 dues to date. The treasurer was not in attendance and no financial report given.

It was reported that there were approximately 20 children that participated in the third annual Easter egg hunt. It was enjoyed by all in attendance.

Island maintenance was discussed. The proposal given by neighbors to maintain the "old pool area" was discussed. No resolution was decided.

Gene Pate volunteered to head the committee to restore the entrance signs. He will work on volunteers to assist and to see where they can obtain the water to power wash before painting. Adam reported the water had been turned off a couple of years ago because of a leak in the sprinkler system at the Dorsey Lane island and that no repairs had been made.

Jerry Clark was thanked for donating and planting four large new rose bushes at the Dorsey Lane island in place of the 6 dead azaleas bushes.

Angela Lechleiter, Vice President, discussed the starting of the new Foxboro facebook page. She explained it would be in addition to the Foxboro email system and the Nextdoor email site.

Angela also discussed the possibility of a summer family event and said that discussion would continue at the next meeting.

Nancy Clark, Secretary discussed the planning of her twentieth annual neighborhood garage sale on Saturday, June 17th from 8-2. The sponsoring and marketing will be done by Nancy.

Discussion of the need for repaving of our county streets. It was decided that Marilyn Parker's office would be notified of the request to repave the entire Dorsey Way.

Marybeth Szwed, Gene Pate, Wendy Rogers volunteered to work on the welcoming committee chaired by Nancy to welcome neighbors that have moved in since the committee disbanded.

Nancy discussed the neighborhood trash service with Rumpke. It was recommended to contact Waste Management to see if a better service is now available.
