It's that time of year again! As a reminder, or for anyone new to the neighborhood, Foxboro asks that each household contribute to the Neighborhood Association Fund.

Your \$50 dues contribution is very important to the safety and upkeep of our neighborhood. Your dues are the sole source of funds for yearly expenses throughout the neighborhood, including paying for the streetlights (this is a cost that comes 100% from contributions, and last year 70% of our collected dues were used just to pay LG&E). We also use a very small amount of our dues to pay for maintenance and sprucing up the neighborhood islands and common areas, for communications and routine neighborhood business, and to help fund the few small social events we offer each year. With greater contributions from our neighbors, we can do even more to enhance the character and appeal of our community, so please do your part! THANKS to all those who have already paid for the year!!
