And welcome to all the new Foxboro residents.

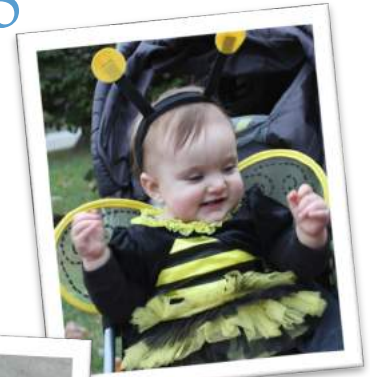


## Save the Date! Upcoming Foxboro Events

## Streetlight out near you?

Any resident of Foxboro can call LG&E when a streetlight is burnt out or needs some sort of repair. However, the board has set up an online account with LG&E where we can easily submit a service request so if you prefer simply send an email to the neighborhood email address and we will report the problem. Please be very specific about where the streetlight is. LG&E makes these repairs within a few days.



## Clean Up After Your Dog

Even in the winter, even in the dark, even if it's a kid, dog walkers are required to pick up after their dog. This should be considered common courtesy but beyond that there is a *metro ordinance requiring it*. You can find a link to Louisville's animal ordinances on the Foxboro web site. 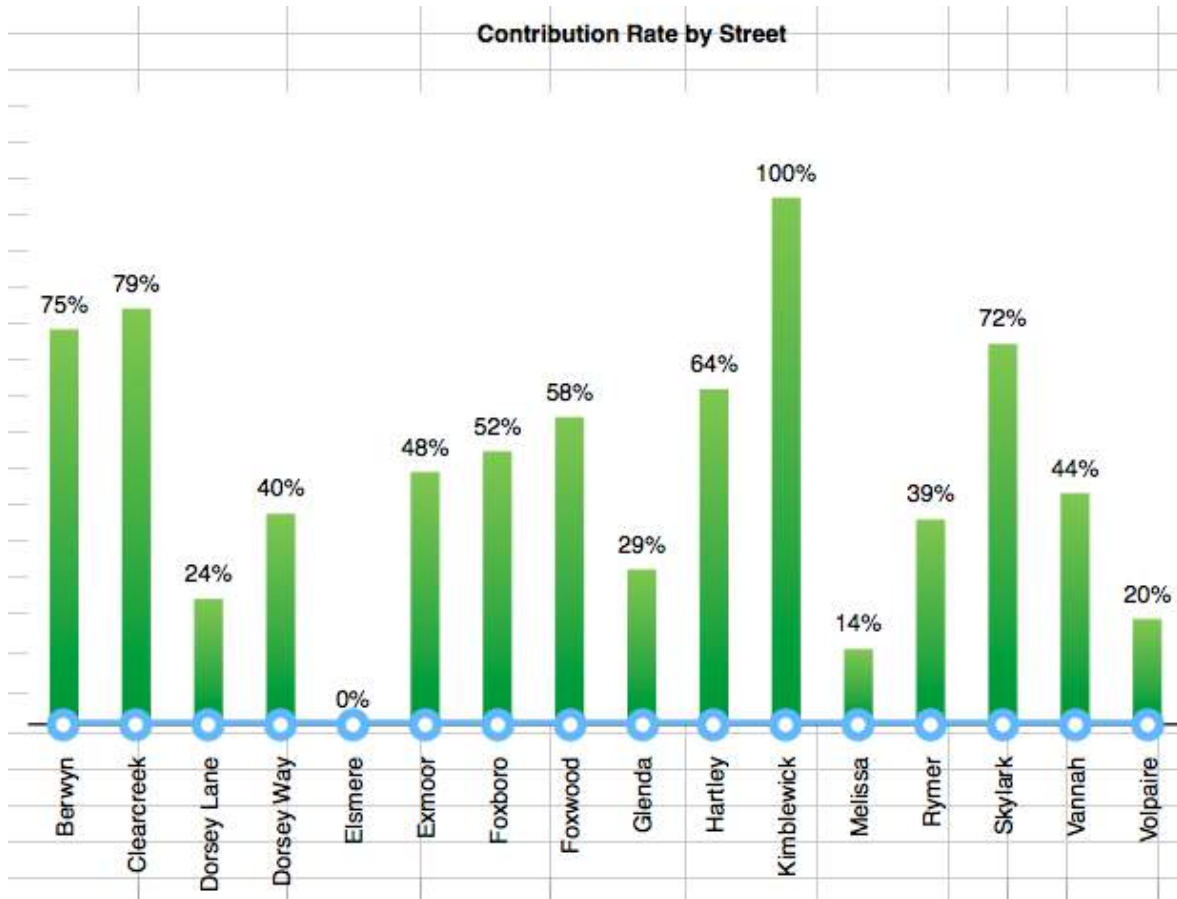


## Rumpke Yard Waste and Recycling
